

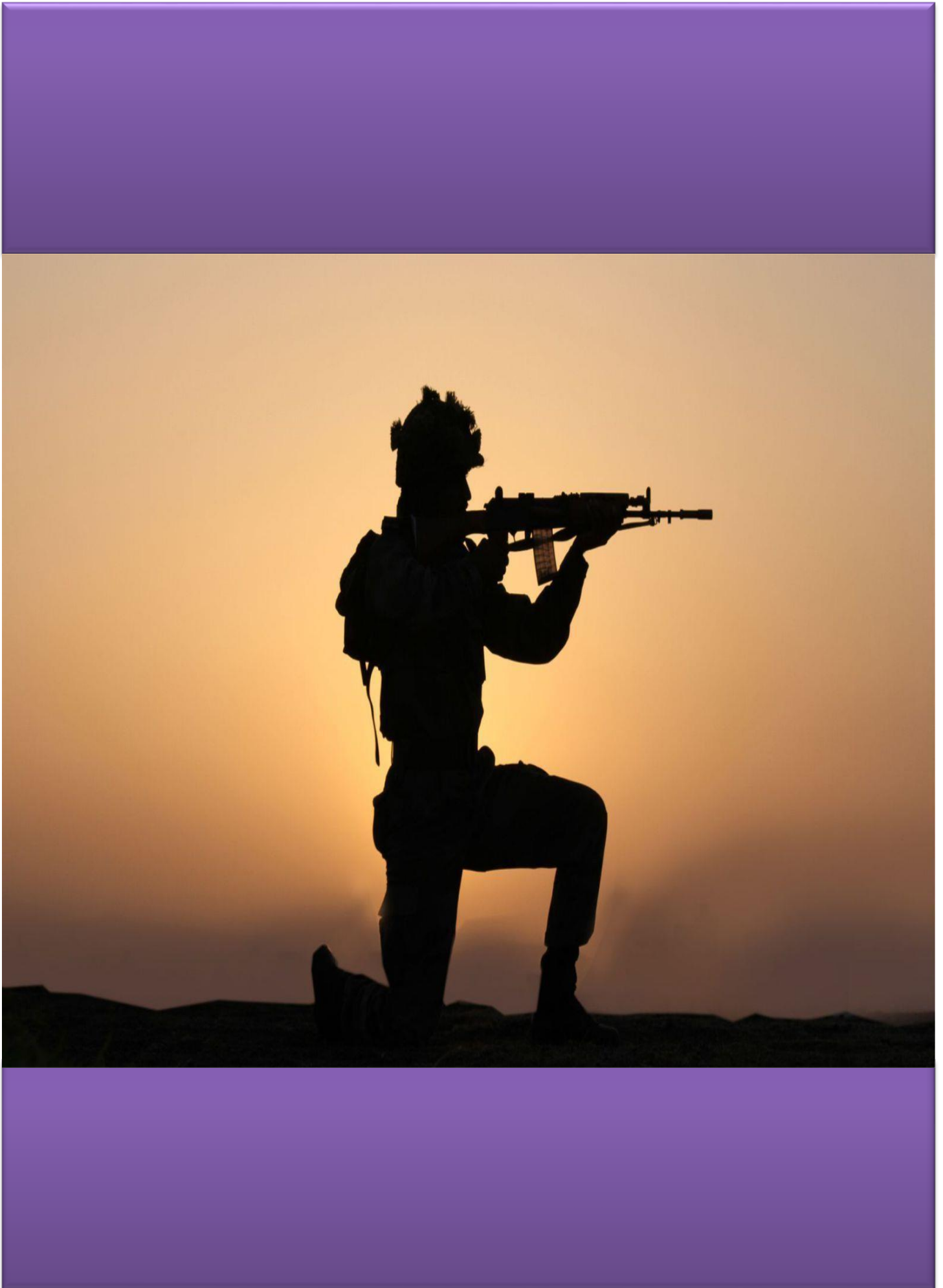

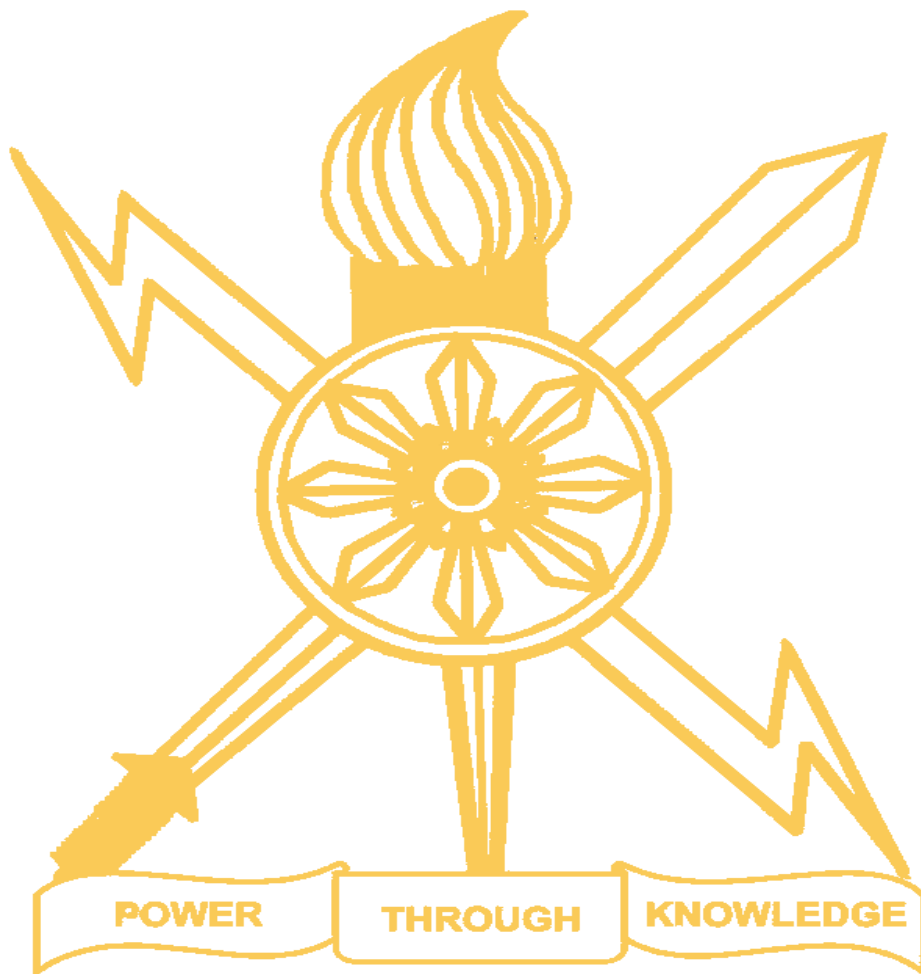

PART I – GENERAL

Introduction

1. The 10+2 Technical Entry Scheme was started to improve the intake of technically qualified officers in the technical arms, tailor made to the service requirement. The first TES Course reported at the Indian Military Academy in the year 1999. The Cadets Training Wing made a humble start on 08 Jul 2000 when the first course, known as 'Pioneers' reported from IMA, Dehradun. Since then, CTW, CME has been producing officers ready to lead men beyond the call of duty.

Brief History

2. The Cadets Training Wing, CME was formally inaugurated by Lt Gen RJ Mordecai, PVSM, Commandant, CME on 17 July 2000. The Wing was initially set up at ET Quarters near the CME Harkirat Singh Open Air Theatre. Later, the Wing moved to its present location in November 2002 and the first course passed out on 15th May 2003.

3. In just a short span of 24 years, the alumni have left deep imprint on the environment. The alumni have done the Wing proud by their outstanding performances as proficient engineers by rendering their services in the most extreme conditions, as instructors in many training establishments and also by numerous acts of bravery in the face of the enemy. **Till date 34 Alumni of CTW have won Gallantry awards which incl One Kirti Chakra, Two Saurya Chakras, Twenty Five Sena Medals (G) & Three Sena Medals (D) & Three Mentioned in Despatches.**

4. Till date, **1159 Officers** have passed through the portals of Cadets Training Wing, CME to become a part of the glorious Indian Army. The institute is further poised for a major expansion in the times to come, with all the required infrastructure and amenities coming up.

5. The Wing is located near CME lake and bird sanctuary which is an epitome of natural beauty. The Wing is presently organised into two Coys, Bhagat and Rane. Each Coy is further divided into three Pls. Bhagat Coy Comprises of Alpha, Bravo & Charlie Pls and Rane Coy Comprises of Delta, Echo & Foxtrot Pls.

6. The OCs of the Wing have the option of pursuing Engineering in Civil & Mechanical streams apart from personality grooming which is spanned over the course of three years aimed to transform

young boys into Gentlemen & future military leaders, who in times to come would bear the onus of defending our great nation. While at the Wing, the Officer Cadets also have an opportunity to pursue sports such as sailing, rowing, golf, tennis, squash, equitation indoor shooting apart from exploring their creative talents such as music, dramatics, pottery, sketching, painting & murals during club activities with dedicated trainer for each.

Aim of Training

7. The aim of training at the Cadets Training Wing, College of Military Engineering is to train and motivate the Officer Cadets to be morally upright, professionally competent, commissioned officers of the IA committed to the values of duty, honour and selfless service to the Nation with the passion to achieve professional excellence.

Key Result Areas

8. The training focuses on following Key Result Areas (KRAs):-

- (a) Inculcate amongst the Officer Cadets, attributes of honour, integrity and loyalty.
- (b) Develop a high std of physical fitness and mental robustness.
- (c) Development of self-motivation and zeal to excel.
- (d) Encourage analytical & creative thought process and develop good comn skills.
- (e) Foster good etiquettes and social graces amongst the Officer Cadets. (f) Develop interest towards pursuit of military knowledge.
- (g) Officer Cadets on passing out, should be technically proficient in their respective B Tech domain.
- (h) The Officer Cadets, on passing out, must be able to lead a section in Battle.

Technical Training

9. The training structure involves three years of training at CTW, CME, which is divided into six terms. This is followed by one year of training at Indian Military Academy (IMA), Dehradun post which the Officer Cadet will be commissioned as Army Officer from IMA, Dehradun.

10. CTW provides intellectually stimulating course content, which goes beyond stimulating delivering information. The technical training at CTW is centred at conferring B Tech degree in two disciplines of Engineering, namely Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering. A Officer Cadet can choose either of the two disciplines. On graduating from CTW and IMA, the Officer Cadet will be conferred with a B Tech degree from Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, which is one of the most valued universities in the field of engineering.

11. The curriculum of both Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering streams at CTW, CME is inclusive, covering all aspects of technical training. Officer Cadets not only participate in technical seminars on varied and contemporary technologies but also undertake industrial visits to the prominent industries and sites in Pune.

Outdoor Training

12. The Outdoor Training includes Physical Training, Swimming, Drill and Equestrian. The Officer Cadets are mandated to clear their tests in stipulated time. Competitions for outdoor events are also held every term.

Military Training

13. **Tactical camps**. Officer Cadets undergo two Tactical camps of five days each which are conducted over their three years training at CTW. They are given field training on Conventional and Counter Insurgency Operations. The camp culminates with the Josh Run and Firing.

14. **Weapon Training**. Weapon Training forms part of the military training at the CTW where a Officer Cadet is taught about weapon handling at squad posts which is followed by firing at the ranges.

15 **Leadership Training**. Specially structured training on leadership qualities is organised for the Officer Cadets. Standing in front of a body of troops and commanding them requires a considerable level of confidence and public speaking skills. To inculcate the same, various activities including Debate Competitions are held in each term.

Organisation and Layout

16. The Commandant of the College of Military Engineering is of the rank of Lieutenant General and the Deputy Commandant and Dean is of the rank of a Major General. The Cadets Training Wing is commanded by a Colonel ranked officer, with 13 officers from all arms and services as Instructors Class A/ B.

Weather

17. Pune has a pleasant climate all-round the year conducive to training, with a mean temperature of 24⁰ C. The campus of CME enjoys a pollution-free environment with a wide variety of flora and fauna. The year begins with mild winters during which blankets are necessary. The period from March to May sees the temperatures gradually rise with the peak experienced during June. The onset of monsoons in late June/ early July brings welcome relief from summer heat. The monsoons continue till end September. The weather thereafter is mild and the winter sets in November/ December.

Focus Areas

18. During training at CTW CME, the emphasis is on the following:-
- (a) Developing Officer Like Qualities (OLQ) among OCs.
 - (b) Gaining proficiency in at least two troop games.
 - (c) Gaining proficiency in at least one indl/ Offr game.

- (d) Identifying and encouraging flair/ interest for Sailing/ Rowing and nurturing their talent.
- (e) Improving overall social skills and personality of OCs.
- (f) Inculcating reading habits.
- (g) Continuous improvement in way of living.

Training Period

19. The total period of training at the College will be four years as per following details:- (a) Pre-commission Training at CTW, CME Pune - Three years. (b) Pre-commission Training at IMA, Dehradun - One year.

 - (d) **Legal Bond to be signed by the Parent & Guarantor of Officer Cadet selected for initial training with a view to being commissioned in the Regular Army** signed by the Officer Cadet's parent & guarantor No. 1 & 2 on each page as per **Appendix E** attached. (Please ensure the Notary does not miss any Para/Line while typing on Stamp paper).
 - (e) Supplementary Legal Agreement Bond **Appendix 'F'** for Cadets unable to produce any of the following: -

- (f) **On joining, the candidate will deposit 10th & 10+2 education certificates & marksheets in original with CTW, CME along with five attested copies of each. He will not be allowed to undergo training at CTW, CME until the same are deposited.**

- (g) Domicile Certificate issued by competent authority i.e, Gram panchayat/ Tahsildar/ SDM.
- (h) Data Entry Form (Particulars of Cadets) (**Appendix G**).
- (j) Proficiency certificate, if held in outdoor activities/sports should be brought by the Officer Cadet.

23. On selection for admission to the CTW, CME the following are required to be deposited by the candidates at the beginning of each term either through: -

(a) Bank Draft of ₹ **71,021.00/- (Rupees Seventy One Thousand and twenty one only)** in favour of “**Pay and Accounts Officer, CME, Pune**” (Name and UPSC Number of the candidate to be written on the reverse of the Demand Draft).

(b) Breakdown of Initial deposit by a First term Officer Cadet on arrival is given in succeeding paras.

(b) Items to be brought by the Officer Cadet at the time of Joining CTW, CME is attached at **Appendix P**.

(c) Apart from the sums mentioned at sub para 25 (a) above, candidates are advised to bring an ATM card linked to his bank account, the balance of the same should not exceed Rs 30,000, this may be required for miscellaneous personal expenses during the process of settling down initially.

25. **Medical**

(a) **Vaccination**. Candidates should be vaccinated against Chickenpox virus. Candidates who undergo the vaccination prior to joining will be required to produce a medical certificate duly signed by an authorized medical practitioner. Officer Cadets who do not get vaccinated on their own will be inoculated with two shots of Chickenpox vaccines at an interval of 6-8 weeks.

(b) At the time of joining the wing, following vaccines are administered to the Officer Cadets under Government expenses: -

26. OCs will bring along a medical certificate on the format attached at **Appendix M** signed by a qualified medical practitioner or a Military Medical Officer. In absence of this certificate they will not be admitted in the Wing.

27. If a candidate is exposed to any infectious or contagious disease, he should immediately inform the Adjutant, Cadets Training Wing telephonically. Under no circumstances, will the candidate report directly to the wing with such a medical condition.

28. A thorough check for permanent body tattoo(s) of all the Officer Cadets will be carried out at on their arrival with details as given in their dossiers. Any deviation to this will entail cancellation of candidature of Cadets.

29. **Indenture**. Please read the notes at every Appendix carefully and comply with the instructions.

30. **Risk Certificate**. No candidate or his parents/guardians will be entitled to claim compensation for any injury, bodily infirmity or death which may be sustained in the course of/as a result of training or surgical operation or anaesthesia given to the Officer Cadet at the Cadets Training Wing, CME during the course of his medical treatment. A copy of the declaration to be signed by the parents/guardians is attached to the Instructions at **Appendix 'C'**.

31. **Legal Agreement Bond**. A copy of the declaration to be executed by parents or guardians of all Officer Cadets is attached to these instructions at **Appendix 'D'** called **Legal Agreement Bond**. This is to be completed on a **non-judicial stamp paper** signed by the parents/guardians and handed over to the Adjutant, CTW, CME on arrival. Regarding value of stamp paper please read **Note (a) of Appendix 'C'**. The following action will be taken by the CTW, CME in all cases on non-receipt of the executed bonds:-

(a) If Officer Cadet is unable to furnish the bond at the time of arrival at the institution, 10 days training charges will be deducted from his account. Such Officer Cadet will be given only few essential items of clothing till he furnishes the bond.

(b) If after 10 days the bond is still not received, the Officer Cadet will be sent home on leave upto seven days and may be permitted to rejoin if he brings the bond or money towards the cost of training for 15 days which is Rs 32,250/- (@ Rs.2150/- per day).

(c) The amount charged above will be refunded to the Officer Cadet on production of the bond by the parents/guardians.

(i) Sufficient amount will be advanced to the Officer Cadet by the CTW, CME for his journey home for collecting the bond. The amount paid to the Officer Cadet for this purpose will be re-imbrued to the CTW, CME subsequently by the parents/guardians.

(ii) If the bond is not received within 25 days of the Cadet reporting to the Wing, the Officer Cadet will be sent home and his candidature will be cancelled.

32. **The Risk Certificate (Appendix 'C') and Legal Agreement Bond (Appendix 'E') should be executed and signed at the place provided for the signature by the father of the candidate only. In case father is not alive, then mother should execute and sign the documents. If both are not alive, then Guardian should sign. If father of the candidate is alive but estranged from family or in case of separation between parents the mother or legal guardian should execute Appendix 'D'.**

33. **Supplementary Legal Agreement Bond.** Candidates who do not submit their original educational certificates at Army Headquarters, also asked by CTW, CME are required to give a declaration to be executed by parents/guardians. A copy of the declaration is attached to these instructions at **Appendix 'F'**. This will also be on non-judicial stamp paper signed by parents/guardians and handed over to the Adjutant, CTW, CME on arrival. Similar action as in the case of Legal Agreement Bond (**Appendix 'E'**) will be taken by CTW, CME in all cases on nonreceipt of the executed bonds (**Appendix 'E'**). **The agreement form should not be stamped or executed until the Government has selected the candidate, and the candidate has received his joining instructions.**

Clothing and Equipment

34. Items to be brought by the Officer Cadets at the time of joining is att as **Appendix P**. In case you fail to bring the items as mentioned at **Appendix P**, please bring money in lieu. All the items are available at CME. The items are likely to cost Rs. 12,000/- (Rupees twelve thousand only).

35. **Free Issue of Clothing and Equipment.** Free issue of necessary items of uniform and equipment will be made on arrival at the CTW, CME. These items of clothing and equipment will be withdrawn on completion of training at the wing.

36. **Free Books and Stationery.** Officer Cadets will be provided with free academic books and stationery at the commencement of each semester. The books however, would be withdrawn at the end of the semester.

37. **Items to be issued in the Academy and cost recovery from Officer Cadet at the time of joining CTW, CME.** Items of clothing and equipment to be issued to the candidates are given at **Appendix 'O'** to these instructions. Candidates whose shoe size is 12 or more are to forward their names, UPSC Number and Merit number in advance at email id "**ctwcmepune@gmail.com**".

38. **Social Media.** The use of social media is banned for the Officer Cadets (list attached as **Annexure to Appendix 'L'**). The candidates joining CTW, CME are required to submit a certificate on the prescribed format stating that the individual is not a member of any social networking website (**format attached as Appendix 'L'**).

Physical Conditioning

39. It is imperative that candidates desiring to join the CTW, CME attain a certain degree of physical fitness which will facilitate their smooth adaptation to the trainings schedule at the wing. It has been observed that a majority of selected candidates are in poor physical condition on joining the wing. As a result of this, such candidates find it difficult to cope up with the training routine. Inadequate physical conditioning also inhibits the Officer Cadets' academic performance.

40. Prospective candidates are, therefore, advised to keep themselves in good physical condition, by following the under mentioned regimen daily: -

- (a) Jogging 3 to 5 Kms interspersed with short sprints.
- (b) Skipping.
- (c) Push ups and Sit ups (minimum 40 each).
- (d) Chin ups (minimum 04).
- (e) It would be of immense benefit if the Officer Cadets could learn the basics of swimming before joining the wing.
- (f) Cycling upto 3 Kms.

Travelling Expenses

41. Candidates will travel to Pune at their own expense by train in AC-III tier by the shortest route. A cash receipt/ticket is to be obtained from the railway authorities showing the amount of railway fare spent. This is to be attached to the Travelling Allowance claim, which will be produced by candidates on arrival at the CTW, CME. Failure to produce the railway receipt/ticket will result in foregoing the claim. Reservation and berth charges are also reimbursed against proper receipt/ticket numbers. Claims in respect of travel by modes other than train would be restricted to the AC-III tier railway fare or the actual expenditure whichever is less.

PART III- ADMINISTRATION

Connectivity

42. Pune is well connected by road, rail and air to all major cities of the country and accordingly move to CTW, CME can be planned. Pune has an international Airport near Lohegaon. It has daily flights to & from all parts of the country.

Reception Arrangements

43. **All Officer Cadets of TES-51 Course will report at Reception Cell, Cadets Training Wing, College of Military Engineering, Pune by 1800hrs on 28 Jun 24.** A reception cell will be established at Main Gate, College of Military Engineering for receiving

candidates. For candidates reporting early/late due to limitations of mode of travel, the same needs to be informed telephonically to Adjutant, CTW, CME to ensure necessary arrangements. Candidates are also advised to avoid staying at hotels or residences of their relatives before reporting. Instead, candidates are advised to directly report to the wing. The Mob number of reception cell is as under:-

Candidates must carry their photo identity proof at the time of reporting. In case of failure to produce the same, they will not be allowed to enter the premises of CTW.

44. Reception Cell will be established at Main Gate, College of Military Engineering. Hence all Candidates shall report directly at the Reception Cell at at College of Military Engineering under own arrangements. The Google maps link of main gate of College of Military Engineering is- <https://maps.app.goo.gl/4reB6gDQuKHDyPk39>

- (a) Candidates can contact Adjutant, CTW, CME on telephone (020-27156560/9557602116) in case of any difficulty.
- (b) Candidate should be dressed in shirt and trouser (or appropriate formal attire according to climate) and should be clean shaved with trimmed hairs when reporting at Reception Cell. Round neck T-shirt or Jeans are not permitted to be worn at the time of reporting.

On Reaching CTW, CME

45. **Discipline.** On arrival and while under training at the Cadets Training Wing, Officer Cadets will be subject to rules and regulations as laid down for the Officer Cadets of Cadets Training Wing. Drinking and smoking is forbidden for cadets during stay at the wing.

46. **Prohibited Items.** The list of items that are prohibited and not permitted in possession of Officer Cadets at the CTW is as under: -

- (a) Dogs or other pets.
- (b) Personal cars, motor cycles and bicycles.
- (c) Air Gun, Pistols, Firearms and ammunition.

- (d) Private servants.
- (e) Wines, spirits and liquors.
- (f) Cigarettes, smoking materials and intoxicating materials (including drugs).
- (g) Electrical appliances including fridge, heater, portable television and high fidelity music systems, etc.
- (h) Smart phones and basic mobile phones.
- (j) Credit Card.
- (k) Laptop/ personal Computer/ accessories to include Hard Disc, Pen drives, Graphic Equalizer, CD/ DVDs etc. (If brought, the same can also be deposited with the Adjutant on arrival).
- (l) Jewellery, Curios and other such valuable items.
- (m) Pornographic Material.
- (n) Medicines and supplements.

47. **Accommodation and Messing.** Officer Cadets will be provided free accommodation and free messing including allied services like electricity, water and conservancy and laundry.

48. **Visitors.** Officer Cadets are permitted to receive visitors on pre-designated Sundays/Holidays from 1000H to 1800H. Officer Cadets are not allowed to entertain visitors apart from the days and timings laid down.

49. **Correspondence.** Personal Number and Platoon will be allotted to Officer Cadets on arrival at the CTW, CME. All correspondence to Officer Cadets will be addressed as under:-

50. **Telephone Calls/Enquiries.** After reporting and initial setting of the Officer cadet, Telephone calls to officers/authorities at Cadets Training Wing should be kept bare minimum. In case of any query/emergency, Parents/guardians are advised to make calls directly to the Platoon of the Officer Cadet and **not to the Adjutant**, once the Officer Cadet confirms his allotted Platoon and Platoon Commander's telephone number.

Leave and Vacations.

51. Leave or absence during period of training will not be granted under any circumstances, except for leave on medical grounds. The Wing closes for term break for approximately four weeks in June and December, when OCs are permitted to proceed home.

52. OCs will be permitted to proceed home during term break subject to certain conditions like passing certain mandatory tests with basic minimum standards. The final decision as to whether or not they should be permitted to proceed home during the vacation shall, however, rest with Commander, CTW. Certain adventure hikes are also organized for OCs to various places of interest around Pune during midterm break. OCs are entitled to free railway conveyance on warrant during the term breaks, to their home stations and back. OCs are advised to plan family functions during these term breaks. **No leave will be granted in between the term.**

Out Pass/ Visitors

53. **Out Pass.** Officer Cadets are permitted to visit Pune City on nominated Sundays/ holidays after passing laid down standards in Drill.

54. **Visitors.** Officer Cadets are permitted to receive visitors on Sundays and Gazetted Holidays during the time specified on orders of the Adjutant, CTW. Officer Cadets are not allowed to entertain visitors without prior permission.

Marriage

55. Only unmarried Officer Cadets will be admitted for training at the Cadets Training Wing. Officer Cadets will not be permitted to get married during training.

PART IV- FINANCIAL MATTERS**56. Financial Assistance.**

- (a) Officer Cadets will be required to meet their personal expenses at the Cadets Training Wing.
- (b) Government has sanctioned a scheme for grant of financial assistance to Officer Cadets whose parents or guardians income is less than Rs 5000/- per month from all sources and are not able to meet their pocket expenses. The rates of financial assistance are subject to revision from time to time. Presently the rate is Rs 400/- per month and is available for the period of training except last one year when the Officer Cadets are paid stipend @ Rs 56100/- per month. To avail the facility of Government financial assistance, Officer Cadets or their parents or guardians will be required to submit an application on prescribed form only. Specimen is as per **Appendix G**. The application should be attested by the District Magistrate or Deputy Commissioner only. Signatures on behalf of District Magistrate or Deputy Commissioner are NOT acceptable. It is pointed out that the certificate is liable to verification and false information will lead to disciplinary action, including withdrawal from the training. This financial assistance, if sanctioned, will take effect from the date of commencement of the course or of reporting at the CTW, CME, whichever is later.
- (c) In order to avoid unnecessary correspondence with parents or guardian, Officer Cadet will ensure that the first term's pocket money allowance i.e. for five months is deposited on their arrival. Thereafter they are required to deposit the pocket money allowance at the beginning of each term.
- (d) The pocket money allowance, whether paid by the government or met by their parents or guardians, will be credited to their personal account and will be given to them as and when required to meet their personal expenditure. The first payment after the arrival of Officer Cadets at the College will only be made in the beginning of the month following the one in which they report arrival.

Insurance: Army Group Insurance Fund Scheme for Officer Cadets

57. **Coverage.** All Officer Cadets who join CTW, CME are covered under this scheme during their stay at CTW, CME.

58. Benefits

- (a) **Insurance.** A sum of Rs 15 Lacs is assured for death due to any reason, while under training at the wing.
- (b) **Disability Cover.** A maximum of Rs 15 Lacs is payable for 100% disability, proportionately reduced upto 20%. No disability benefits are paid for alcoholism/drug

addiction. The percentage of disability will be recommended by a military medical board and approved by a competent authority, which will be considered final and binding on the Officer Cadets. Officer Cadets leaving at their own request or on disciplinary grounds will not qualify for any disability benefits, under this scheme.

(c) **Survival Benefits**. No survival/maturity benefits are applicable during training at CTW, CME.

59. **Premium during Training at CTW, CME**

- (a) A onetime non-refundable premium of Rs 7,200/- will be paid on joining CTW, CME.
- (b) The premium is compulsory and will cover the Officer Cadet for a period of three years in CTW, CME.
- (c) There is no saving elements; hence no maturity benefits are payable when the Officer Cadet leaves the Wing.
- (d) **Relegation Cases**. If a Officer Cadet gets relegated to junior course on Academic, Administrative or Disciplinary grounds, he will be liable to pay Rs 1,355/- for each additional term (06 months), immediately when such relegation becomes effective.

60. **Premium on Passing Out of CTW, CME**. Once the Officer Cadet joins IMA, Dehradun and commences drawn of a fixed stipend of approximately Rs 56,100/- per month, he shall pay Rs.10,000/- per month (subject to periodic revisions). This monthly subscription shall continue even after Commissioning, till the individual remains in service. The premium contains saving element hence will be entitled for maturity benefits on leaving the IMA on any ground.

61. **Disqualifying Factors**

- (a) Officer Cadets who abscond or desert the wing i.e. leave the wing without proper permission/ authority, will not be eligible for any benefits under this scheme.
- (b) Officer Cadets leaving the training at their own request or on disciplinary grounds will not be eligible for any disability benefits even if recommended by a medical board.

Stipend/Pay

62. The Officer Cadets of TES Entry are not paid any stipend during the training period at Cadets Training Wing, College of Military Engineering Pune.

PART V – FACILITIES

Sports and Cultural Activities

63. Considerable emphasis is laid at CTW on outdoor and other character-building extracurricular activities. The extensive facilities available for games and sports include a swimming pool, a well-equipped gymnasium, several squash and tennis courts, a golf course and a large number of play fields for hockey, football, cricket, basketball, and other games. The College has a wide inventory of water sports equipment with an excellent Sailing Club and an Olympics standard Rowing Channel.

Hobbies/ Clubs

64. Cadets Training Wing aims to develop an enduring interest/ hobby amongst OCs. With this aim, a variety of hobby clubs are encouraged in CTW to include Dance, Music, Dramatics, Arts, Nature and Photography, Information Technology and Innovation, Equitation, Squash, Tennis, Golf, Archery, Sailing and Rowing .

65. Officer Cadets can join the club of their choice. They may bring club material, such as musical instruments, personal camera, sports equipment, arts material, etc. which they possess. Joining one of the clubs is mandatory.

Games

66. Games are an important part of the curriculum in the Wing. The major activities include Hockey, Football, Basketball, Volleyball, Tennis, Squash, Golf and Equitation.

67. In case Officer Cadets are in possession of any sports gear, they are encouraged to bring them along. Possession of one hockey stick and one pair of football boots is mandatory and should be brought by the OC. In addition, protective gear and individual games equipment may also be brought along.

Recreation and Shopping Complex

68. **Movies.** Movies are screened twice a week for Officer Cadets in the Harkirat Singh Open Air Theatre at CME. English Movies are screened on Wednesday and Hindi Movies on Saturday.

69. **Ante Room.** Each Platoon in CTW has a well-furnished Ante Room for OCs to socialise/ interact during off parade hours. The Ante rooms have a good ambience and facilities for

entertainment to include Television with a DTH connection, Billiards/ Pool Table, Table Tennis, a mini library etc.

70. **Shopping Complex/ Cafeteria.** OCs have access to shopping areas in CME as under :-
- (a) **CME Shopping Complex.** Provides shops for general requirements and accessible on Sundays.
- (b) **CTW Shopping Complex.** The complex has a Tailor Shop, A General Store and Juice Shop and a Saloon.
- (c) **Mess Tin.** The CTW Cafeteria provides food and beverages for OCs during off parade hours. OCs can entertain guests in the cafeteria, on nominated days/ Sundays.
71. **Army Canteen.** There is a well-stocked CSD canteen in CME providing all grocery items required for daily use by OCs. OCs are allowed access to the Canteen on Sundays.

Banking

72. CME has a branch of Punjab National Bank and State Bank of India within its campus, which provides banking facility to all Officer Cadets.

Postal Service

73. CME has a post office within its campus, which caters for all Officer Cadets postal needs. Telegraph service are also available.

Communication Facility

74. **Internet.** Access to internet has been provisioned in the Wing for use by OCs.
75. **Telephones.** CTW has WLL phones available in each Platoon, on every floor, for calling. The OCs are permitted to avail this facility as per timings laid down by the Companies. OCs are not permitted to use any type of mobiles phones. **Possession of any type of phone is strictly prohibited and a punishable offence.**

**Basic Phones (Dumb Phones) are permitted on Sundays/ Holidays from 1000h. The same needs to be deposited in Platoon Office on arrival (if brought) and will be issued on Sundays/ Holidays.*

76. **Medical.** CME has a Medical Inspection Room and a Dental Centre. Military Hospital is close at Kirkee and a Command Hospital is located in Pune, which have specialist officers posted for all medical specializations.

PART VI: SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

77. **Ban on Applying other Jobs while at the CTW, CME.** Candidates who have also applied for other types of commission/entry into the Army, Navy or Air Force or any other employment must exercise their final option before admission to the CTW, CME. After admission, they will not be permitted to appear for any examination/interview for any other type of commission/entry in the Army, Navy or Air Force or any other employment without resigning from the Cadets Training Wing and paying the cost of training.

78. **Resignation or Withdrawal: Recovery of Cost of Training.** In case Officer Cadet tenders his resignation on arrival or later during the course of the training or is withdrawn by the Government for not fulfilling the conditions laid down in paragraph 4 of the Bond at **Appendix 'D'**, he and his parents/guardians are liable to pay to the Government jointly the cost of training at CTW, CME and other training establishments and money received by the Officer Cadet as pay and allowances together with interest thereon. **The cost of training is revised from time to time and is presently slabbed at Rs13,940/- per week**, with an yearly escalation of 8% to be calculated on 01 July of each year. **The cost of training will be recovered from the date of joining the Wing.** The Officer Cadet who tenders his resignation/ is withdrawn will be returned his 10+2 Education Certificate/ Marksheet (original) only after clearance of all his dues (including cost of training).

79. If Officer Cadet tenders his resignation, he has to submit his Parents' consent along with resignation application. The format of the Parent consent is attached as **Appendix 'J'**.

80. The cost of training incurred at RIMC, Dehradun and the amount of scholarship received at various Sainik Schools will also have to be paid by the Officer Cadet or his parent before a request to resign is accepted. The amount involved will have to be deposited prior to forwarding the case to higher authorities.

Liability for Cost of Training

81. The cost of training, messing and allied charges/services including cost of used clothing items, ordnance & private kitting will be recovered from the Officer Cadets who resign from the Academy. Similar recoveries will also be made from the Officer Cadets who are withdrawn from the Cadets training Wing for the following reasons:-

- (a) Violating any provisions of the Bond executed by the Parents/Guardians at the time of the joining.
- (b) Knowingly furnishing false particulars or suppressing material information in his application for admission to Cadets Training Wing.
- (c) Being withdrawn on Disciplinary Ground.
- (d) For marrying while under training.
- (e) In case an Officer Cadet does not accept a commission, if offered.

MoU : Lateral Absorption into Poornima University, Jaipur for OCs Withdrawn on Medical Grounds

82. The Officer Cadet joining the CTW have qualified 10+2 education with science subject by obtaining at least 60% of total marks, from a recognized board or university and mandatorily appear in JEE (Mains) for applying for the TES entry Scheme.
83. Officer Cadet, who becomes medically unfit due to injury or accident sustained during the course of strenuous physical outdoor training imparted in the CTW are withdrawn from the course for not meeting the laid down physical Quantitative Requirements (QR) for Armed Forces. Such Officer Cadets therefore are not commissioned into Indian Army, on account of having been boarded out. However, there is a system in place for such Officer Cadets to allow them readmission into engineering course to complete balance semesters at Poornima University, Jaipur.
84. **Eligibility.** Officer Cadets will be eligible for admission to the B Tech Degree programme offered by Poornima University, only if :-
- (a) Boarded out on Medical/ Outdoor training ground.
 - (b) Officer Cadet has passed the last semester at CTW, CME & IMA, Dehradun before being boarded out in the current semester.
 - (c) Submits willingness certificate to join the B Tech programme at Poornima University in continuation with the semesters already completed with CTW, CME & IMA, Dehradun.
 - (d) Submits the fees as applicable as per Poornima University regulations for enrolment in B Tech Degree.
85. Based on the recommendations of the Joint Executive Committee, the case/ report will be prepared for transfer/ admission of Officer Cadet from JNU, New Delhi to affiliated college of Poornima University.
86. Poornima University shall provide admission to eligible Officer Cadet, post ratification, to complete his Engineering Degree as per the stream allotted.

PART VII: CONCLUSION

87. The Cadets Training Wing aims at providing the Officer Cadets a stimulating environment that encourages an individual to develop his mental faculties as well as affords ample opportunity to improve his physical abilities. At CTW, CME a Officer Cadet is groomed into a **dynamic and robust person who is fit to serve in the Indian Army as an officer**. Being an Engineer also entails having a 'Thinking Mind' and the training is also tailored to develop this aspect. The Cadets Training

Wing trains Officer Cadets to be future officers of the Indian Army capable of upholding the ideals of the Corps of Engineers and the Indian Army by dint of a sharp intellect in an able body.

Government on account of the Cadet on his training and all the money received by the Cadet in pay and allowance from the Government together with interest on the said money calculated at the rate in force for Government loans.
